



DECLARATION OF COMPLIANCE **REACH-SVHC**

The European Union legislation entitled “Registration, Evaluation, Authorization and Restriction of Chemicals” – went into effect on June 1, 2007. The REACH regulations require registration (with some exceptions) of every chemical substance imported into the European Union in quantities greater than 1000 kg. The obligation to register the materials is on the specific individual or entity manufacturing or importing such material in Europe.

Since M2 Global Technology, Ltd. is an article (component) producer and the products we supply shall not release any substance under normal or reasonably foreseeable conditions of use, therefore according to the legislation, specifically Regulation (EC) 1907/2006, Title II, Chapter 1, Article 7.1 (a) and (b), it is M2 Global’s understanding that the products M2 Global sells constitute **non-registerable articles for their intended and anticipated use.**

Additionally, M2 Global's products do not contain any Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC) as defined in Article 33 (1) & (2) “Substances of Very High Concern” EC Title VII, Chapter 1 Article 57 and revised as noted below (see note 1).
